The world is divided in two industries. One is the war industry and the other is the peace industry. And the people in the war industry they are really together. They don't have to talk to each other even, they know exactly what they want to do. They wanna go out there, kill and make money. But the people in the peace industry, which are us, we are so idealistic that each one of us criticises the other peace person in the peace industry. And we are always just arguing and we are wasting our energies doing that, so let's just forgive each other and see that we are in the peace industry and that's all that counts.
